Operational	Property that is actively used by the City of Asheville for municipal purposes and operations	Government headquarters, administrative buildings, maintenance and operations buildings, industrial facilities, warehouse and storage yards, and other systems / infrastructure network sites	City Hall, Fire Stations, Police Stations, Water Treatment Facilities, Public Works Facilities, etc.
Stewardship	Properties that are associated with community recreation, open space, or environmental preservation	Parks, community centers, natural areas, watersheds, iconic properties	Aston Park, WNC Nature Center
