Until further notice, the City has extended permission to medical service providers for use of the covered breezeway at the Pack Square Park PavillionÂ for the purpose of providingÂ medic support during occasions of public assembly in downtown Asheville. Related supplies and materials may not be left unattended.

1. The City is making an exception to the enforcement of after-hours occupation of the park, expressly limited to the medical providers and the individuals actively receiving medical support.Â

2. The curfew does not apply to medical providers.

Banners or signage to identify theÂ covered breezeway as a medical support location will be allowed at the pavilion at both entryways in a manner taking care to ensure the building is not damaged. Limited tables and chairs to support theÂ operation may be used but may not block ingress or egress through the covered area or entryways to interior areas.

The Pavillion restrooms and water fountains are not operational due to the COVID-19 pandemic.Â
