Witnesseth: - That the said parties of the
first part, for and in consideration of the sum
of One Dollar to them in hand paid by the party
of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged, have given, granted, bargained, sold
and conveyed, and by these presents do give, grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of
the second part, its successor or successors and
assigns, all that lot, tract, piece and parcel of land,
situate, lying and being in the Town of Sylva, in
said County of Jackson, State of North Carolina, and
more particularly described and bounded as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the 10.
