



Report for State Agency Licensing Boards

Fiscal Year 2020-2021

July 1, 2020 – June 30, 2021

Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 93B-2(e) the NC Department of Insurance Bail Bond Regulatory Division compiled data to align with the reporting requirements below:

No later than October 31 of each year, each State agency licensing board shall file electronically with the Secretary of State, the Attorney General, and the Joint Legislative Administrative Procedure Oversight Committee an annual report containing all of the following information:

- (1) The number of applicants for a license and, of that number, the number granted a license.*
- (2) The number of applicants with a conviction record and, of that number, the number (1) granted a license, (2) denied a license for any reason, and (3) denied a license because of a conviction.*
- (3) The number of applicants with military training and, of that, the number (1) granted a license and (2) the number denied a license, and (3) a summary of the reasons for denial.*
- (4) The number of applicants who are military spouses and, of that, the number (1) granted a license, (2) denied a license for any reason, and (3) a summary of the reasons for denial.*

As provisions in Chapter 93B were amended to include state agency licensing boards, the division did not submit this report for Fiscal Year 2020-2021. This report has since been created to reflect our best estimates in response to a public records request. The table below summarizes reporting requirements from the Bail Bond Regulatory Division for State Fiscal Year 2020-2021.

Bail Bond Regulatory Division obtained the data for this report from Pearson Vue, a third-party vendor, operating the electronic filing database, Pearson Credential Manager “PCM” System. PCM processed all applications during this reporting period and is currently no longer being utilized by the vendor. Applications that were pending administrative hearing or applicants that failed examination for licensure, are not reflected in this report.

* This number reflects completed applications that the division reviewed for licensing. 462 applications were processed by PCM during this reporting period; however, 228 applications were withdrawn or determined to be incomplete.
