Please see attached. You'll see a blank for the address, and the property owner's name will need to be filled in. If you want to add, or change anything, feel free. Chief, you ask for more warrants than I do, so if there's magic language they'll want to see that I didn't add, please let me know.

You should ask the magistrate if you can add in that a Town of Columbus officer and (whoever the inspector is) can accompany the Housing Administrator—Tim, on the warrant. I don't know if they will or not.

If they don't, the administrator could be on the road, shouting questions back and forth, you could have him on facetime/or something similar as you walk through, or he could just tell you what to look for, take photos of.

It's likely that the administrator has the ability to pursue a warrant as well, and if that's the case, we may want a second warrant authorizing him to inspect/search too.
